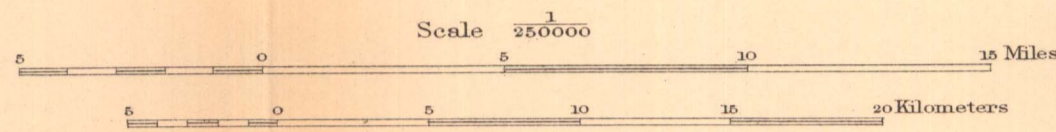


RECONNAISSANCE MAP OF THE ILIAMNA REGION ALASKA



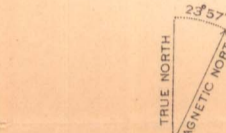
Contour interval 200 feet
